

1. Clean the tyre properly. If the tyre is new or you previously used another type of tyre shine, you must use a powerful degreaser!

Shampoo and a high pressure wash is not enough

The grease from the new tyre that is usually brown and the silicone products used for shine in other brands doesn't let the product stick properly.

2. Let the product dry completely because in contact with water the product will be diluted and it may turn white.

3. Apply the first layer evenly on the tyres. When you finish the last tyre, you return to the tyre you started with and apply the second layer for more shine.

4. Let the product dry for at least 30 mins. In cold temperature it may take up to 2 hours to dry completely. If not dry, the product will turn white in contact with water or could drain down the tyre while spinning and dry after with a few marks.
